EXCELLENCE IN LANDSCAPE PROFILE

This design included a raised negative edge pool, framed by two custom water bowls, that takes advantage of the waterfront site location, creating two levels for visual interest and seating for large parties. A four-foot stone wall with columns, complete with custom mahogany gates, serves as the entrance into the space, paired with crape myrtles planted behind the wall to provide screening. A raised sun terrace was designed to take advantage of the sunny site location, while a custom-arched, mahogany pergola was constructed over the lounge area in front of the stone fireplace to offer the refuge of shade. Pennsylvania flagstone with Indiana limestone accents, drawing from the existing materials, were used for the patio and terrace. The large expanse of hardscape was softened by the use of colorful shrubs and perennials to provide year round interest. 🌿
